

# HOW TO SWEET SPRING

## CLUB COUTURE™ PROJECT

### Supplies Needed

**Club Couture™ Transfer:** Sweet Spring

**Chalkology™ Paste Singles:** Green Envy, Honeydew, and Peony

**Tools:** Small Squeegee, Fuzzing Cloth, and Permanent Marker

**Surface:** Couture Gallery™ Board Aiden White Frame (9" x 12")

**Additional supplies needed:** Bright White Chalkology™ Paste and Multi-Tool from Club Couture™ Kickstart Kit

### Color and Placement for Club Couture™: Sweet Spring

1. Sweet Spring: Bright White, centered on board.
2. Vines: Green Envy, one set each at the top and bottom of board, paired together to frame phrase.
3. Large flower: Peony, centered between vines at the bottom.
4. Dotted blossom: Peony, paired with green vines at top, pointing downwards.
5. Rounded bud branch: Bright White, overlaid on green vines at the top and another to the right of the large flower at the bottom.
6. Heather flower: Bright White, to the left of large flower at the bottom, curving upwards.
7. Two leaves: Honeydew, beneath green vines at the bottom, curving downwards.
8. Small flower: Honeydew, three between green vines at the top and one overlapping on the right of the large flower at the bottom.

### Follow these instructions to complete the Club Couture™ project:

1. Prepare your board by wiping it clean of any debris or dust.
2. Prepare your Chalk Transfer™ by removing it from the packaging and cut apart the individual elements. Label the backer papers with marker to correspond with the image. This will make cleanup easier.
3. When you remove the backer from the Transfer screen, be sure to "fuzz" each element to gentle the adhesive by sticking the adhesive screen to a Fuzzing Cloth or terry cloth towel to pick up a bit of lint before applying it to your board.
4. Position your desired Transfer element and smooth to adhere to your surface, ensuring there are no bubbles.

5. Prepare your Chalkology™ Paste by tearing off corners of the Paste Singles packets and squeezing desired amounts onto a dish or other palette surface. Stir paste if using 3 oz. jar.
6. Use a generous amount of Chalkology™ Paste on the Small Squeegee or Multi-Tool and smooth it over the Transfer (see color and placement suggestions below).
7. Once the screen portion of the design is completely covered, squeegee the excess paste off as evenly as possible and scrape unused paste back into the jar or palette. The more excess paste you remove, the better the result.
8. Carefully peel back the Transfer before the paste dries and immediately put it in water to clean thoroughly. Once clean, let dry with sticky side up.
9. For best results, wash and dry each Transfer element and the Squeegee before reusing.
10. Repeat these basic techniques as you proceed with each element of your design. Allow sufficient dry time of your surface (or use a hair dryer to speed drying) before layering subsequent steps.
11. Once all the Transfer elements are clean and dry, reapply all backers, and store flat.
